Tomoaki Watanabe was born in Tochigi city, Japan, in 1972. From 1999 to 2001, he got a Research Fellowship for young Scientist from the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS). He received the Ph.D. degree from the Tokyo Institute of Technology (TIT), Yokohama, Japan, in 2001. From 2002 to 2005, T. Watanabe was an Assistant Professor of the Materials and Structures Laboratory, Tokyo Institute of Technology. Presently, he is a Professor of Department of Applied Chemistry, Meiji University, Japan. He is mainly interested in inorganic material synthesis: Nitride, Oxi-Nitride, Nonomaterials, Photo catalyst, Lithium ion battery electrode materials, ammonothermal synthesis, hydrothermal synthesis, solvothermal synthesis. In 2007, he was recipient of the Prizes for Science and Technology, Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), Japan.
