

BIOGRAPHY: Daniel Crespy

Daniel Crespy studied chemistry at the University of Strasbourg (France). He joined Professor Katharina Landfester to complete a PhD of chemistry in 2006 in the University of Ulm (Germany), where he developed novel methods to prepare nanocapsules in miniemulsion. He held then a position as project leader at Empa (Swiss Federal laboratories for Materials Research and Technology), working on stimuli-responsive materials for textile applications. He joined the department of Professor Landfester in the Max Planck Institute for Polymer Research (Mainz, Germany) in July 2009 as group leader. Daniel Crespy is now Associate Professor since 2016 in the Vidyasirimedhi Institute of Science and Technology in Rayong, Thailand. His main research interests are materials for biomedicine, self-healing, and anticorrosion. His contribution was published in more than 100 papers.
